As she is preparing to submit her thesis, which investigates Huguenot refugee memoirs written after the Revocation of the Edict of Nantes, she will discuss the final stages of a multi-year research project, focusing on strategies for dealing with large bodies of material and restructuring drafts in the process of 'writing up'.

This presentation will be followed by a **Roundtable Discussion**, which will allow students to (re-)introduce themselves, reflect on the year ahead, and discuss current research projects in an informal setting.
